Class 5a Senior Area 14 Teams	Two team members compete in BRC HT 90 Q and showjump at max 75cm, and two compete at BRC HT 100 Q and show-jump at max 85cm. Best three scores count. Horses must have up to date vaccination records.	£60 per team Area 14 qualifier only
Class 5b Senior Area 14 Individual	The highest placed individual in each arena not part of a qualifying team will qualify, tests as above. BRC RULES

BRC Eligibility

Combined Training 75cm:

Unlimited prelim points, 0 points at novice or above, 0 BE points, 0 BS points.

Horses may be registered with BE but must not have any BE points, or have been placed in the top six at BE 90 or to have completed a BE 100 or above in the current or previous calendar year at the close of entry.

Combined Training 85cm:

Unlimited novice points, up to 35 elementary points, 0 points at medium or above, maximum of 10 BE points, maximum of 225 BS points.

Those with borrowed horses should check eligibility on points and winnings. No pony or horse may compete in more than one section of the Area Qualifier.

Clubs must pay a prelim entry of **£29** per team, **£9** per individual to British Riding Clubs at least 21 days before the date of the qualifier above (Sunday 12th March 2017) Entry forms can be found on the BRC website for postal entries, www.britishridingclubs.org.uk and online entries can be made via the BHS bookshop www.britishhorse.com. Late prelim entries may be accepted with a late surcharge of £20 per team or pair and £10 per individual. Late entries are not guaranteed and permission must be sought from the organiser in the first instance before payment is made.

Equine influenza

Your horse must have an up to date vaccination records ready for inspection, and these should be presented by team managers to the Official Steward for checking prior to competing.

Objections and queries

Any queries should be addressed to the BRC Official Steward officiating at this event.

Tack and Dress Rules

Please make sure you adhere to current BRC tack and dress rules. The full 2017 Rulebook is available to download online. If you have a query on the rules, please ring BRC on 02476 840593. All hats must meet current BRC Riding Standards and have a visible orange BRC hat tag in place before they are used for warming up and competing. There will be a trained steward at the competition to tag your hat for you if it doesn't already have one. Please allow extra time when collecting numbers.

A body protector is strongly recommended in show jumping competitions, which must meet current BRC Riding Standards and be fitted and worn as per the manufacturer's instructions. Hybrid Air-jackets are permitted. Riders wearing Exo Body Cage protectors must inform the secretary at all events.

Local Rules

The organisers have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the Health and Safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the written and verbal instructions of the organisers and stewards.

Carleton Riding Club shall not be liable for any claim in respect of damage, loss, injury or accident to anyone, horse or property howsoever caused in connection with or arising out of this show.

The judge's decision is final. Any objections must be made in writing to the Show Secretary within 30 minutes of the cause and be accompanied by a £20 deposit refundable only if the objection is sustained.

The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry or amend the schedule. The organisers will not tolerate disruptive behaviour from horses or riders.

All dogs must be kept on a short lead at all times.

Please pick up your droppings and any rubbish, we have to leave the car parks as we found them. Please don't tie up haynets outside.

Professional and amateur photographers will be present. By entering these classes you are deemed to have accepted that photographs of you will be taken and they may be used for publicity purposes. In the event that you do not wish to be photographed, please inform the show secretary in advance.
